## The correct way to sort and put out your household garbage

~Put out your garbage by 8AM on the day of collection!~

### Burnable garbage day Weekly on

<p><b>Kitchen waste</b> (Please ensure it is dry!)</p> <p><b>Waste oil</b> (Impregnate waste oil into paper or cloth.)</p>	<p><b>Waste paper / Smelly Paper</b></p>	<p>Please cut twigs and branches to less than 40cm in length and tie with string. ### Non-burnable garbage day Weekly on

<h4>Plastic bottles</h4> <p>Items marked "PET" (drinking water, alcoholic drinks, soy sauce)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make sure you remove the cap</li> <li>Plastic caps → Plastic containers and packaging</li> <li>Peel off the label → Plastic containers and packaging (Paper labels are burnable garbage)</li> <li>Rinse the inside thoroughly with water</li> <li>Crush the bottle</li> <li>Put bottles in the blue basket (small or large). Put them straight in; do not put them in a bag first.</li> </ol> <p>Please take any bags you use for bringing things out back with you</p>	<h4>Plastic containers and packaging</h4> <p>Items marked  (PE, PP, PA, PS)</p> <p>※ Please wash dirt off before putting out.</p> <p>Plastic products (except PET bottles)</p> <p>Candy bags, frozen food bags</p> <p>Styrofoam, trays</p> <p>Plastic bags</p> <p>Please do not put one bag inside another</p> <p>Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (plastic bag or shopping bag)</p> <p>All items not marked , items with dirt on them, items which have not been rinsed out, cassette tapes, video tapes etc.</p> <p>Put these in burnables</p>	<h4>Other papers</h4> <p>(Newspapers, cardboard, magazines, shredder garbage, item other than paper cartons)</p> <p>Envelopes</p> <p>Wrapping paper</p> <p>Postcards</p> <p>Carton ※ Open it out</p> <p>Remove cloth twine and metal fittings from paper bags.</p> <p>Tie up with string</p> <p>Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (plastic bag or shopping bag) (Paper bags also OK)</p> <p>Items with dirt on them, packaging with foil lining inside, items with a strong smell (e.g. incense or detergent) etc.</p> <p>Put these in burnables</p>	<h4>Hazardous items</h4> <p>Thermometers; blood pressure monitors; fluorescent tubes</p> <p>Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (plastic bag or shopping bag)</p> <p>Cigarette lighters; dry cell batteries</p> <p>Separate each one and put it in a bag.</p> <p>Use up oil inside</p> <p>Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (plastic bag or shopping bag)</p> <p>Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (plastic bag or shopping bag)</p> <p>※ Take watch batteries and rechargeable batteries back to the shop where you purchased them</p> <p>Fire extinguishers; car batteries</p> <p>For household use only</p> <p>Put out as they are. (You do not need to empty contents)</p>	<h4>Non-combustible items</h4> <p>Make sure you do not throw out broken items stuck together with gummed tape.</p> <p>Chinaware</p> <p>Mirrors, glassware</p> <p>Thermos</p> <p>Please wrap dangerous items in paper.</p> <p>Nail varnish</p> <p>Makeup compacts</p> <p>Umbrellas</p> <p>Small household electrical appliances (Less than 40cm)</p> <p>Electric shavers</p> <p>Rice cooker</p> <p>hairdryers</p> <p>Hot water dispensers</p> <p>Telephone equipment</p> <p>Gaming equipment</p> <p>Place items in the yellow or red basket. ### Recyclable garbage day (Cans, bottles, clothes, paper, aerosol cans) Weekly on

<h4>Cans; metal items</h4> <p>(Please rinse the inside before putting out.)</p> <p>Empty cans (Steel cans; aluminum cans) etc.</p> <p>Frying pans</p> <p>Pot</p> <p>※ Containers over 1 "to" (c18 ltrs) Items (&gt; 40 cm) } Oversized garbage</p> <p>Tea containers, candy cans</p> <p>Other metal items (Copper, stainless steel, brass)</p> <p>Put items in the blue basket (large). Put them straight in; do not put them in a bag first.</p> <p>Please take any bags you use for bringing things out back with you</p>	<h4>Aerosol cans, gas cylinders for portable stoves</h4> <p>If anything is left in the can, there is a risk it might explode in the garbage collection vehicle</p> <p>Use contents up entirely</p> <p>No need to puncture the can</p> <p>Place items in the yellow basket. Put them straight in; do not put them in a bag first.</p>	<h4>Fabrics</h4> <p>~ Please refrain from putting out garbage when it is raining ~</p> <p>E.g. Blankets, shirts, pants, jeans, socks, underwear, coats, jackets, curtains, sweaters, sheets.</p> <p>Curtains</p> <p>Clothes</p> <p>Light blankets</p> <p>Blankets</p> <p>Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (plastic bag or shopping bag)</p> <p>Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (plastic bag or shopping bag)</p> <p>Please tie the top of the bag before putting out</p> <p>Non-recyclable cloth items</p> <p>Cloth with cotton and feathers which is less than 40cm, Futons, electric carpet, kotatsu covers, mattress pads, electric carpet covers</p> <p>Down jacket</p> <p>Oversized garbage</p> <p>Burnable garbage</p>	<h4>Paper</h4> <p>Divide according to the five types shown below, and tie up with string.</p> <p>-Please tie these up with free paper twine distributed by the city.</p> <p>Newspapers, flyers</p> <p>Cardboard</p> <p>Tied with string</p> <p>Magazines, books, notebooks, dictionaries (Bound publications)</p> <p>Tied with string</p> <p>Paper cartons</p> <p>Open these out, rinse with water and dry before putting out</p> <p>Tied with string</p> <p>Shredded papers (Paper only)</p> <p>Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (plastic bag or shopping bag)</p> <p>Please tie the top of the bag before putting out</p> <p>Any other paper items → Please put in "Other papers"</p>	<h4>Bottles</h4> <p>(Rinse inside before putting out)</p> <p>Reusable bottles: Reusable after washing (returnable)</p> <p>Items with this mark  / Items with this mark </p> <p>Ber bottles, 1 "sho" size bottles (1.8 ltr), Whisky bottles</p> <p>Remove the cap</p> <p>Put items in the red basket. Put them straight in; do not put them in a bag first.</p> <p>Assorted bottles: non-returnable glass bottles (one-way bottles)</p> <p>Remove the cap</p> <p>Put items in the blue basket (small). Put them straight in; do not put them in a bag first</p>

### Oversized garbage

We will give you a designated date for collection on request. We do not accept reservations for specific dates. Thank you for your co-operation.

[Items which are over 40cm on one side count as oversized garbage.]

For each collection, we can take up to 10 items.


※ When your request is received, please attach one of these tickets to each item for collection. For all oversized garbage to be collected, please ensure you attach one collection ticket to each item.

For all shops or anyone putting out garbage, please refer to the "Oversized garbage collection day schedule" (separate sheet).

For additions or changes please contact us at least in the morning of the previous day before the collection date. (If the previous day of the collection day is a Sunday, a national holiday, year-end or New Year, contact the office by the day before each day.)

### Garbage which cannot be collected by the city


How to deal with these garbages:  
Ask if you can take the item you want to dispose of back to the shop where you bought it, for licensed disposal.  
※ If you are having your home refurbished or altered, please ask the building contractor to take any waste materials away.  
※ For waste materials from home medical treatment, please consult with your medical practice or pharmacy.

For waste related to your business activities, it is the responsibility of the individual trader to deal with this waste according to the relevant laws and regulations. Please deal with your waste correctly under contract with a licensed waste disposal specialist (fee is payable)
